CONDITIONS OF ORDER

Should either regulation be applicable we will supply you with details of end customer, application and final country of destination. You will then be required to confirm whether or not the product is available to us for the particular end customer and application.

You must notify Component Sense if there is:

- a change to processes, products, or services, including changes of their external providers or location of manufacture and, where required, obtain Component Sense approval in writing before shipping
- any changes in purchased product, prior to the implementation of any changes that affect the ability of the purchased product to meet the specified purchase requirements
- any non-conforming product regarding any parts stated on this order. You must notify Component Sense in writing as soon as possible and you must obtain Component Sense's approval for disposition (including shipment) of the product in writing

You are required to flow down applicable requirements, including customer requirements, to external providers and the need to ensuring relevant personnel are aware of:

- their contributions to product or service conformity;
- their contributions to product safety;
- the importance of ethical behaviour.
